

Leya's Cat House

Materials:

You will need:



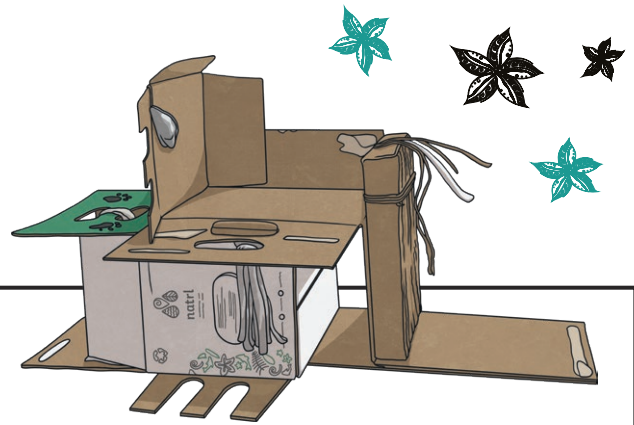
3-4 natrl water boxes and bladders



Adhesive e.g. super glue or hot glue gun

(please make sure an adult is helping you if you are using super glue or a hot glue gun)

Method:



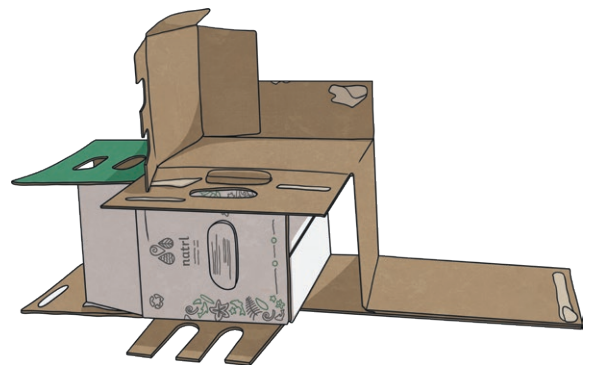

Remove the bladders from the natrl boxes. Open up the top of one of the boxes, lay it on its side, so the cat can go inside the box. You could cut holes in the sides of the box for the cat to see out of.



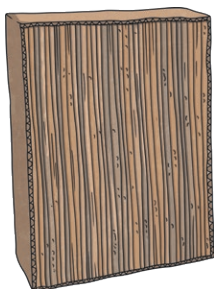

Add an open box on top of the bottom box. You can rotate the top box and cut parts of the box away or unfold parts of it, so that the cat can get onto it easily and has an interesting place to sit. Glue the two boxes together.

Use other spare parts of the natrl boxes to add a scratching post, add cardboard strips for the cat to play with, or add other extensions to the main part of the house.

Use the natrl bladder to create ribbons for the cat to play with, or scrunch it up and tie with string to make puff balls.



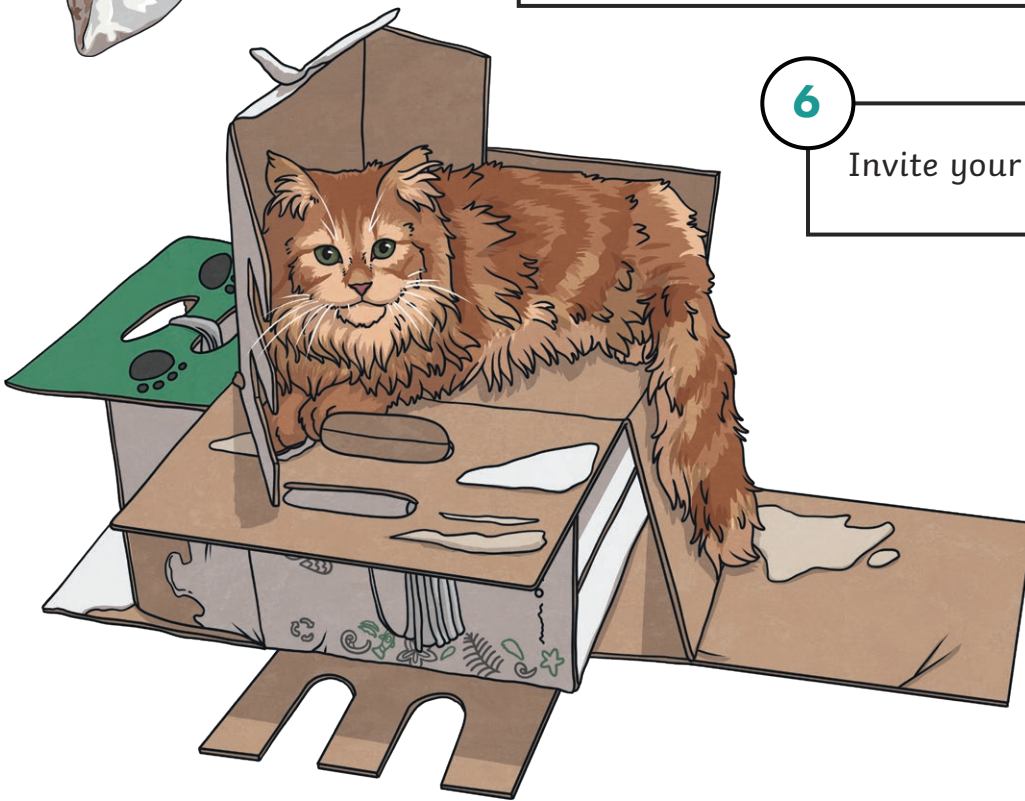

Attach the toys you have made from the bladder onto the cat house. Be as creative as you like when making and attaching these toys.
